

Let's look at what the Bible has to say about faithfulness. How do we know it's important to God?

We are going to dig into 7 key verses on Faithfulness in the Bible.

Deuteronomy 32:4 The Rock, his work is perfect, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness and without iniquity, just and upright is he.

"The Rock" God is unchanging. He is faithful to us. He isn't fickle like us and change with our feelings all too often like the seasons. God stands firm in His perfect and just ways.

How can we become firm and just like Cod? What are some areas you can see Cod wants you to become more

Psalm 91:4 He will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness is a shield and buckler.

I LOVE this verse! I can see and almost feel God wrapping His arms around me. I can feel the security (His faithfulness) and love pouring over me when I need refuge. He is our shield. This is a feeling we should be wanting others to feel around us too. When they know we are faithful to them they can feel secure with us too.

What are you doing today to help others feel safe with you? How could you become that shield for someone?				



Proverbs 3:3 Let not steadfast love and faithfulness forsake you; bind them around your neck; write them on the tablet of your heart.

WOW! Now God's talking about outward and inward faithfulness - around γour neck and the tablet of γour heart. Not only are we to keep faithfulness near and dear to our heart. We should be meditating on it. But others should be able to see it in us. We should be oozing faithfulness - make it so they can't miss it in us. (See also Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Jerimiah 31:33-34)

Lamentations 3:22-23 The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

This is something I want you to really let soak in. Truly meditate and memorize these words. "His steadfast love never ceases...great is your faithfulness." Love, grace, mercy, goodness, forgiveness, truth, compassion and faithfulness - these are the characteristics we need to be focusing on and spending our time nurturing.

How often are we truly showing these characteristics to others? Or are we short, quick to judge and unforgiving How can you give yourself a quick reminder to respond lovingly to others?					nforgiving?



Matthew 25:21 His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.'

This verse is HUGE! Those words we long to hear right?! We are called to be faithful in the little things (not just the things we deem "big"). Be faithful in following through with what you say you're going to do. Be faithful in the smallest of tasks. Prove - show - your faithfulness.

What "little thing" have you let slide because you didn't look at it as a big deal? How can you change your view on this and reprioritize?



Luke 16:10 One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much, and one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much.

Are you seeing that being faithful in ALL THINGS is pretty important to God? Here is yet another verse that is telling us that if we can't be faithful in the small stuff then we won't be able to do it with the big stuff. Dig a little deeper. Pray about it. Meditate on it.

Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.

This verse makes me feel strong in Christ. It takes a strong person to persevere with all of our confidence in our God. For us to truly be faithful we need to be secure in our knowledge that God is faithful first. He leads us by example and we are to follow Him.
